Within 26-28 March 2007, SCOP Timisoara organized in Timisoara (Romania) the first IC training in VIT, within Leonardo project.

The trainers that sustained the course were lecturer Katerina Beaufortova, assisted by aspirant supervisor Cristina Dumitriu.

There were 24 participants to this first IC, from all over Romania, from the NGO sector, and from the institutional sector (General Direction for Social Work and Child Protection) working with different types of beneficiaries (children/teenagers coming from disadvantaged families, or having disabilities, families, adults, etc); social workers, psychologists, psycho-pedagogists, psychiatrics.

After reading the feedbacks of the participants, regarding the training we concluded that the training was very well received, they were very interested on this method and showed further inters to continue with supervision for being able to use, in the future VIT as working tool.

The training was delivered in English, all the participants having good English knowledge.

It consisted in theory and practice in VIT, and the theoretical information offered, and also the practical part were very interested and offered a strong basement for all the participants to get used to this new method.

There were a lot of practical exercises and examples, for offering the participants a clear view upon the benefits and way of using VIT in their work with beneficiaries.
